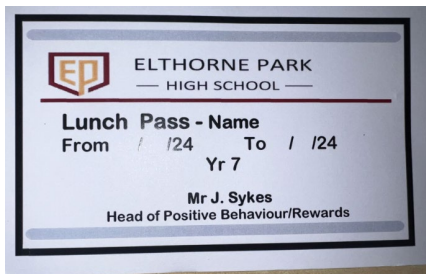

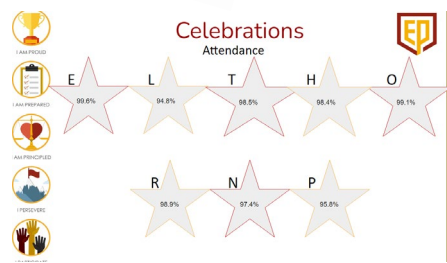

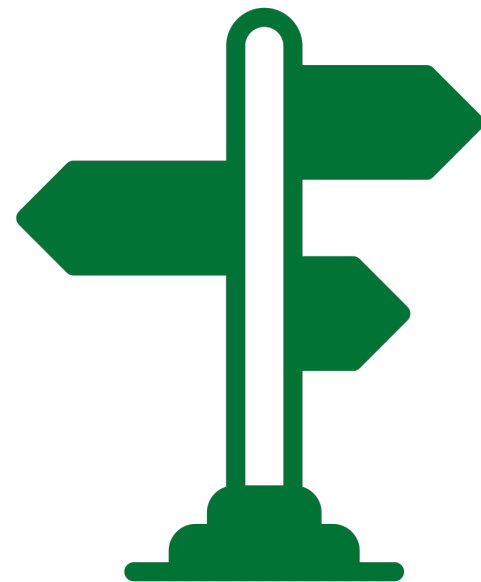

# What do I do if my child is unwell?

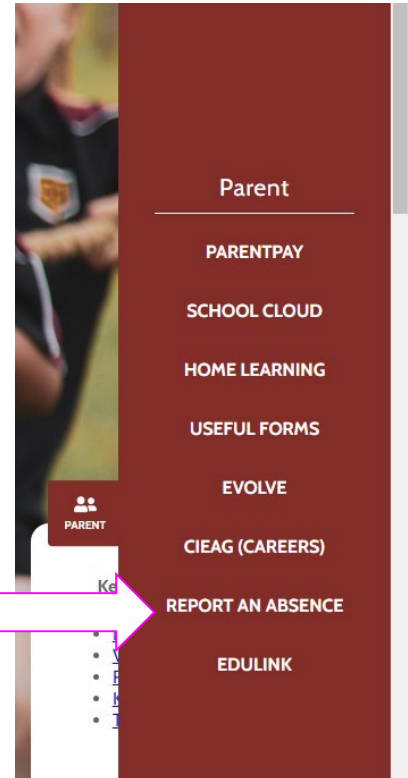
We try to avoid students having days off as it has an adverse effect on their learning and progress.

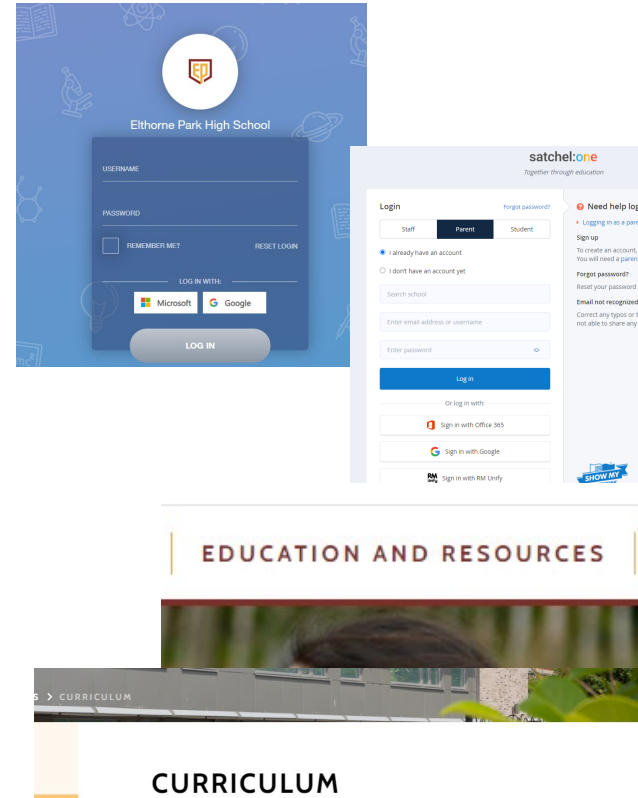
## Accessing information
